Today's assembly was about 'The Big Ask'. We watched a short video from the Children's commissioner for England - Rachel de Souza. You may have heard about this when it was announced earlier in the week. It is the largest ever survey of children and young people aged 4 -17 in England. It is asking children what matters to them, what their life is like, what they want in the future and what they think is holding them back. The children will not be asked for any personal details including their name. The results will be shared with the government so they can see what children need to lead happier lives.
