A message from Miss Whittingham:

It has been a good week. The children have continued to work hard; it is so lovely to walk round school and hear the busy chatter between the children about their learning. Years 5 and 6 had their 'Growing up'/puberty information session on Thursday. The people leading the sessions were impressed with the level of maturity and attitudes the children displayed during the sessions. Well done, Years 5 and 6.

Over the next few days/week, there is going to be some disruption on the playground which might affect where you stand when picking your child/ren up at the end of the day. The disruption is due to school having a MUGA (Multi Use Games Area) installed on the field outside Year 1/2 classroom. We are VERY excited about this and I know the children will enjoy watching the installation as it happens and will certainly benefit from having another area to play on all year round. We have used the Sports Premium Funding from the Government to pay for the MUGA.
