CHARGING POLICY

SCHOOL VISITS:

It is the school's policy to ask parents and carers for voluntary financial contributions to the cost of school visits.

This helps us to extend the number and range of visits available to our pupils during, or mainly during, normal school hours.

These visits will be subsidised by the school from the Educational Visits Fund within the school's budget.

Parents and carers will be asked to make a contribution towards the cost of transport, admission, specific workshop activities etc. but no pupil will be excluded from a visit if a contribution is not made.

However, the school reserves the right to reconsider the viability of a particular visit if insufficient contributions are made.

The Educational Visits Fund will be reviewed termly as part of our regular budget review.

EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:

From time to time we may offer extra curricular activities on school premises which are provided by external agencies and for which these agencies make a charge to parents.

These activities may be keyboard lessons, Science workshops, dance classes or other suitable activities. The agencies making this provision will charge parents directly and any queries relating to payment should be made to the provider.

PTA EVENTS:

Our PTA holds a variety of events during the year and for some of these, such as Discos and Talent Shows, a small admission charge may be made. This money is used to contribute towards associated costs and any profit made is added to the PTA's School Fund account. This money is then used to provide treats, educational equipment, outings etc. for all our children.
