It was lovely to see some Byley faces amongst the children's choir on stage at the Folk & Boat; as ever they sang out and did us proud. The church pillar we decorated was also a joy to see. Our visit to the Cheshire Show on Tuesday was again a success with children enjoying a variety of sights and activities. Children in upper Key Stage 2 have continued the week with exciting visits through to today: on Thursday our Year 5s enjoyed a 'wow' day at Middlewich High School and Year 6 attended 'Crucial Crew' and are now well informed about life skills and personal safety.
