A message from Miss Whittingham:

It has been lovely welcoming all the children back into school this week. Thank you making the changes in line with the drop off and pick up times. Please see below for important messages around pick up.

The warm weather has meant that the children have really enjoyed being outside during break times making full use of the MUGA and field. A few parents have asked about Sports Day. We are intending to have a Sports Day during the first week of July but this will be held behind 'closed doors'. We feel that this is the best thing to do - particularly with the current spike in cases and higher transmissibility of the Delta variant. We are grateful for your understanding with this.

At present, the 'Moving Up Days' are going ahead. However, with the current spike in infection in the local area, we will be closely following Public Health and DfE guidance and may change plans in accordance with advice.

IMPORTANT:

Please wear face masks when on school premises - including when on the playground at the start and end of the school day. This is vital in helping to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

Be aware of distancing from others whilst waiting on the playground, particularly at the end of the day.

The change to pick up times is working well but I am aware of a decline in the wearing of face masks and less adherence to social distancing.

Please take time to note the change to the February 2022 half term holiday.
