A message from Miss Whittingham:

It has been a good week in school. The new Nursery children came for a visit on Tuesday afternoon. The children in Byley Nursery stayed for the afternoon this week. It was lovely to see them all in the hall eating their packed lunches with Mrs Madden. It was a very busy day but there were lots of smiles and happy faces. The eleven Year 6 children going to Holmes Chapel Comprehensive had the opportunity to visit on Thursday afternoon. Judging by the happy faces I saw at the end of the day, it all went well.

If your child has a raised temperature, cough or loses their sense of taste and smell, this could be COVID-19. If you are at all unsure, please book a PCR test and keep your child and any siblings at home until you receive a negative result. The LFD home test kits only pick up 1 in 3 positive cases whereas PCR tests are almost 100% accurate.

Please continue to encourage your child to read at home. Reading for 20 minutes at least three times a week can make such a difference to a child's word recognition, fluency, understanding and confidence. If looks like rain, please ensure your child has a coat in school as we do still go outside to play if it isn't raining too heavily

IMPORTANT:

Please wear face masks when on school premises - including when on the playground at the start and end of the school day. This is vital in helping to prevent the spread of COVID-19.
