I have called into each class this week to see the children 'at work' and was pleased to see their engagement and ever increasing confidence. They grappled with simple, compound and complex sentences in Years 5 and 6; planned work on an explanation text in Years 3 and 4; composed some lovely lines in their autumn poems in Years 1 and 2 and showed some mega maths skills in our Reception class. Mrs King's class have also been working hard in maths using part/whole models.

Our links with Middlewich Primary School – especially the sports department – have benefitted many children this week. Our Year 2's attended KS1 mini superstars on Wednesday afternoon and each day in the playground, our own Play Leaders have set up games and activities for other children, following their Play Leader training with Mrs Denham.
