## This Week...

- In Phonics we have been consolidating our recognition of the sounds taught so far; s, a, t, p, i, n, m and d. We have worked on recognising and reading the tricky words 'I', 'the' and 'my'.
- In maths we practised recognising numbers, identifying the number which is one more. We also measured our feet using cubes. We were very surprised to find a 'big foot' in the classroom for us to measure! The children were very puzzled how that got here! 😊
- In our topic work we have been thinking about our feelings and what makes us happy. We painted pictures of these things using watercolours.

## Next Week...

- In Phonics we will continue to consolidate all sounds taught so far as well as learning 'g, o, c, k' and the tricky word 'to'.
- In Literacy we will practise writing simple sentences using our phonic knowledge.
- In Maths we will continue our work on measurement and counting skills.
