## This Week...

- The Christmas play continues to fill our timetable, whether it be singing, 'dancing' or acting.
- We sung the counting rhyme 'Five elephants go out to play, upon a spider's web one day.' The children loved pretending to be the elephants! The children recorded number sentences based on the rhyme.  $1+1=2$ ,  $2+1=3$ ,  $3+1=4$  etc
- We learned about African elephants and their natural habitat, the children were absolutely fascinated. We read and labelled parts of an elephant's body by sounding out the words. We then listened to a clue about a body part then matched that to the correct part of the elephant's body.
- Our Guided Reading book this week was 'Mr Big has a Party' then they practised writing the HFWs 'can' and 'it'.
- In PE we played relay games which focused on teamwork - working together effectively won the race! Please continue encouraging your child to be as independent as possible when getting dressed and undressed at home.
