Notes for Parents

All pupils benefit from a good relationship between home and school and the school aims to develop the relationship. This agreement formally recognises our responsibilities and is consistent with the school's Behaviour and Homework policies.

The school's curriculum is mainly a statutory framework but we have our own agreed aims which are in the prospectus. These create the ethos in which we want children to grow and develop and they represent our values as a school community. We want children to achieve success and satisfaction in all areas of school life. To this end, we set appropriate targets for each child at the end of Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 in line with Government Statutory Tests and for each child or group of children every term in Literacy and Numeracy.

Overall targets and achievements in school tests are reported to parents and Governors (except in small groups with cohorts less than 11). You are welcome to discuss your child's individual progress at any time by appointment with the class teacher.

All our school policies are reviewed regulary and copies are available to be viewed by parents if required.

All children will be made aware of the school's code of behaviour and parents are asked to support this.

The staff and Governors would appreciate it if parents would sign this agreement, although this is entirely voluntary. Pupils may also sign the agreement when they are mature enough to understand all the rules. However, the absence of a signed agreement does not exempt any pupil from complying with school rules.

The School will try to:

Provide a safe, secure and happy environment by promoting good relationships and dealing promptly with any problems

Encourage children to do their best at all times and aim for high standards

Encourage children to take good care of their surroundings and others around them

Provide a broad, balanced and challenging curriculum, including moral and spiritual development

Inform parents of the children's progress at regular meetings, and provide early warnings of problems if these arise.
