Head teacher's message:

We've had another busy week at school and each class has produced a range of work, in a variety of curriculum areas, of which they are rightly proud.

Years 5&6 painted river landscapes, and wrote broadcast scripts about a flood. Their Science work continued with inventing a fictional animal. Years 1&2 have used maths lessons to create pictograms and graphs and again have developed composition skills with some fantastic writing based on their class novel the Dread Cat.

In Early Years, there has been much planting – of cress seeds and sunflower seeds – and lots of handwashing.

Years 2&3 have been looking at the five senses and using them in their descriptions of 'the shirt machine'. They also worked in maths on fractions word problems.

We continue to follow guidance from the DfE and will advise you if there is a decision regarding schools closure via the **school website**; we are not anticipating this at present but are preparing for the event, should it occur.
