It was good to see so many of you at our Parent Consultation evenings this week. There was good news to share on children's attitudes, enthusiasm and progress since their return to school and I saw countless smiling faces.

I know that Mrs Bebbington will have mentioned it to parents of her Y6 children but I have been asked by the LA to remind parents of children in Year 6 that they only have until the end of this month to apply for a place at high school. This is an online process.

Around school this week:

Years 1&2 have continued to impress us with their descriptive writing.

Years 3&4 have further developed their mathematical skills using their knowledge of place value in addition and subtraction calculations.

Early Years have looked at autumnal changes in the woodland area.

And in Year 5&6, children have been studying Shakespeare's *Tempest* and producing creative storm writing.

Next week we hope to celebrate Harvest in our Friday assemblies and if **each child** could just bring in **one item**, I will make sure they are passed on to the local foodbank in Middlewich.
