Head teacher's message:

Thank you to all who are continuing to wear face coverings, socially distance and make their way home promptly at the end of each school day. We appreciate that it's these little things that keep our school community safe.

We had many features of school life to celebrate at today's assemblies: working extremely hard, trying hard, having a positive attitude and producing wonderful descriptive writing. Our children give us many reasons to be proud of them.

In class, their English work has ranged from writing sonnets (taking their lead from Shakespeare) to punctuation and grammar including commas, prepositions and present perfect tense. Please continue to help encouraging good reading habits, with 10 minutes daily reading at home.

In maths, children have grappled with complex fraction work in KS2 and the beginnings of multiplication at KS1.
