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Adult Guidance

Please find below the reading comprehension questions and some handy talking points for your class after the children have read the minibook. These are designed to be adult-led and encourage discussion either one-to-one, in a small group or with the whole class.

1. What did the scouts have for tea?

Answer: Hot dogs with ketchup.

Follow-up questions:

- Do you think they cooked the hot dogs in an oven or somewhere else?
- Have you ever had a campfire?
- Have you ever made food on an outdoor fire?

2. Did the team make a strong shelter? How can you tell?

Answers might include: No. It fell on Kit. It fell down. Yes it was strong. They made it out of wood.

Discussion points:

- What do you think is the best material to use to make a shelter?
- What would be the best shape for a strong shelter?
- Do you think the scouts attached the sticks together? What could you use to do this?

3. The scouts went on a hunt around the woods. What do you think they might have found?

Answers might include: sticks, leaves, rocks, stones, bugs, insects, feathers, conkers, pine cones.

Discussion points:

- Do you think they saw any animals in the woods? Which animals could live in the woods near here?
- The scouts might have needed to be careful when picking things up. What do you think the dangers might be with picking things up in the woods?
