Sam thought it would be good to sing about elephants. Kit thought it would be good to sing about a typhoon. They chose to sing about an elephant in a typhoon.



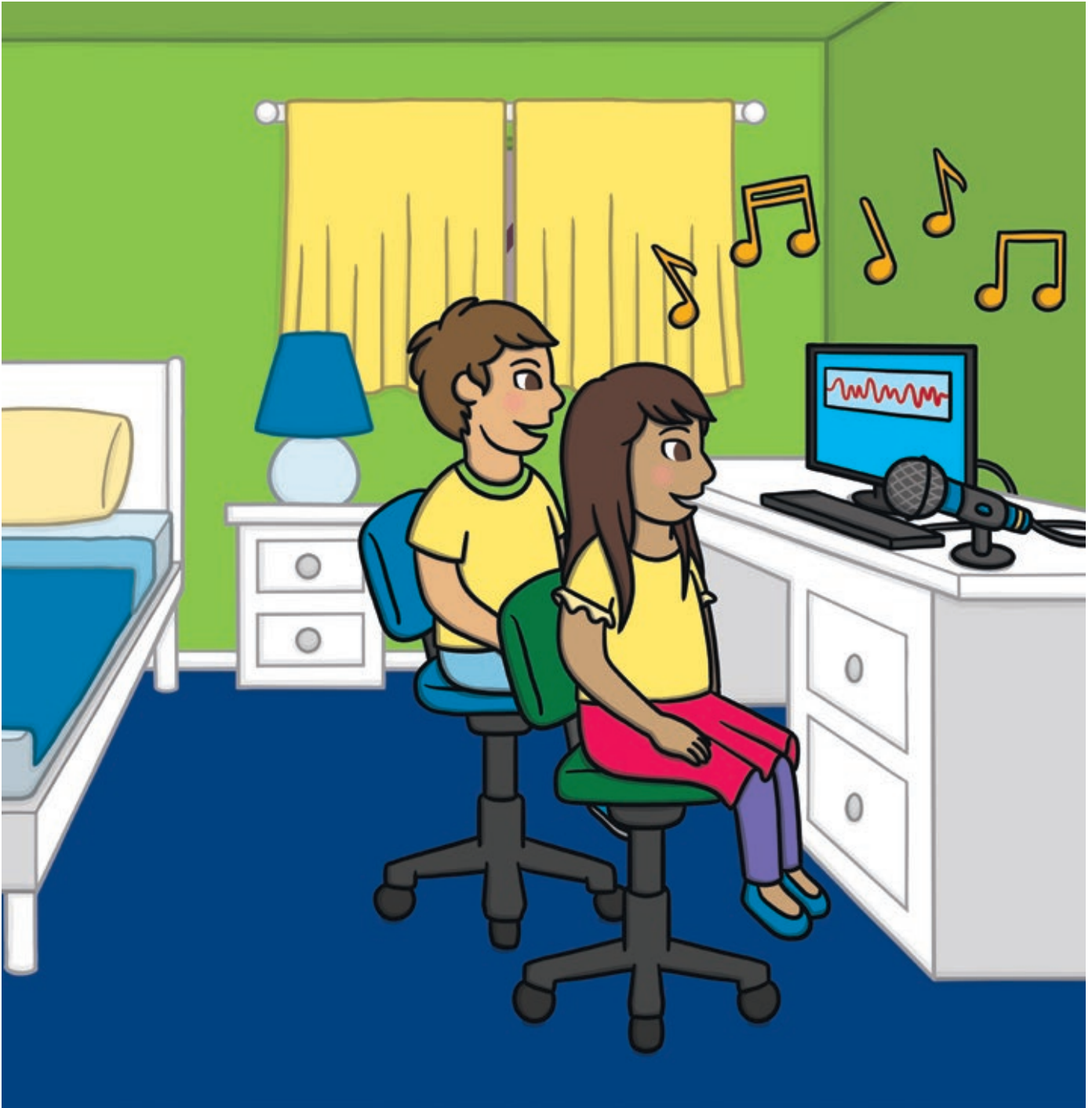
They had to sing the song into a microphone and record it on the computer. On **Wednesday**, they sent the song to the woman from the contest. She would phone the winner on Thursday.
