After the boat ride, we went on the London Eye and saw the city from above. It was amazing! We could see lots of London landmarks, including The Shard.

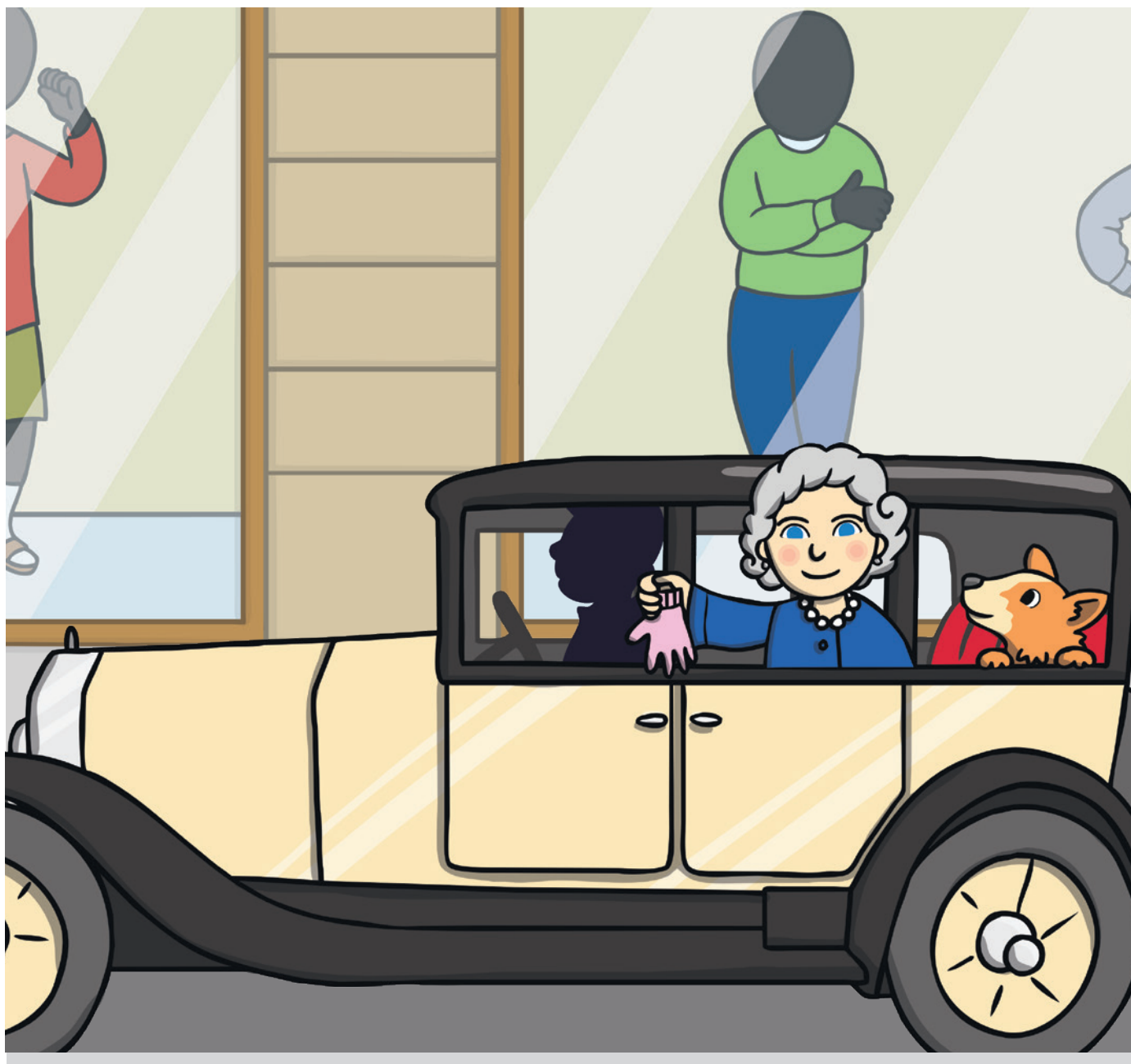


Q3: What did the family see on the boat?
