A 'Let's Read Together!' Book

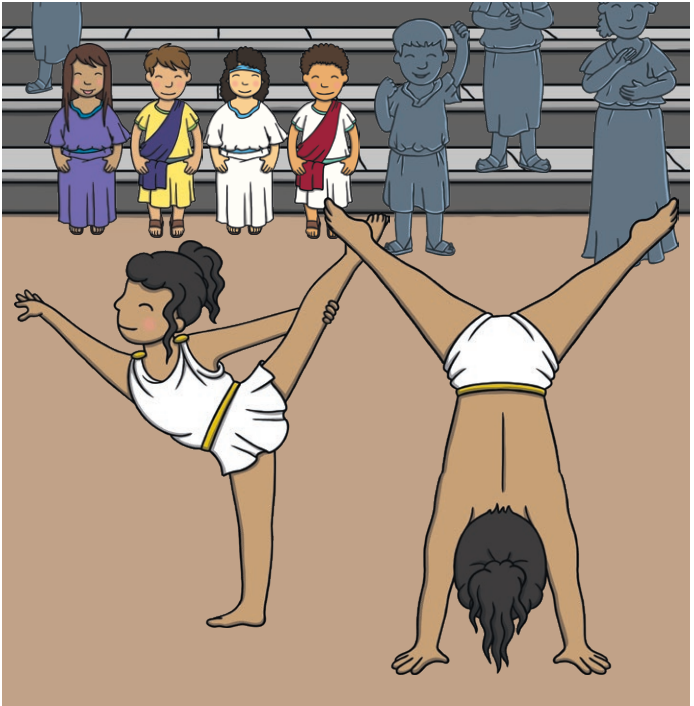

Q1: Where did Athena and Atticus take Kit and Sam to?

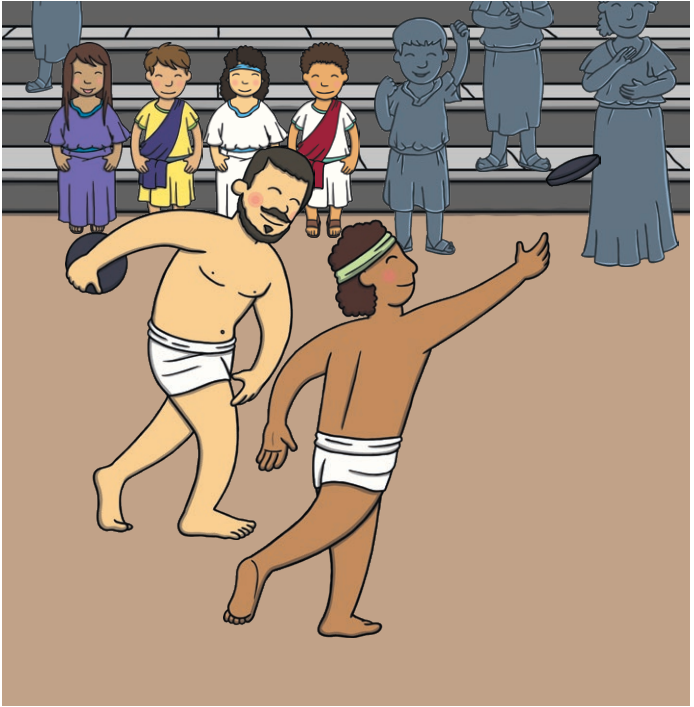
Q2: Which word in the text tells you that it was busy?



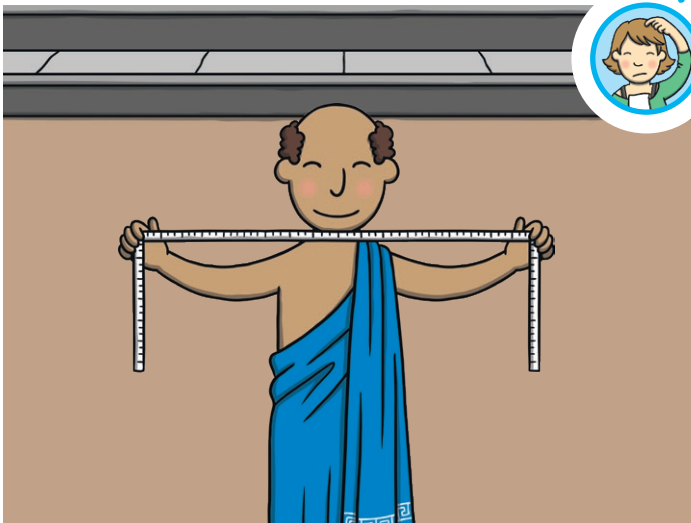
They saw athletes carefully preparing the sports equipment. The friends smiled with enjoyment at the sight of the gymnasts performing a routine.
