




A 'Let's Read Together!' Book






Q1: What did Lily's sister say about Mrs Tillson?

She was cross that someone in the class had disobeyed her rules. She went to her desk and pulled out a magic wand. Then she waved it and made Jake disappear!






Q3: What had happened to Mrs Tillson's interactive whiteboard?


Q4: How do you think Sam and the rest of the class were feeling when Jake disappeared?
