Mrs Madden's Class News Friday 11th October 2024

This Week...

We started the week with a very well attended Learn with Me – Maths (and Phonics!) session on Monday. It was lovely for the children to share their classroom learning with you ... and the adults loved all the baby cuddles, thank you!

The children learned the phonemes: 'h b f l' this week. They've been

- playing hopscotch outside
- playing in the home corner the babies movie night was popular!
- balloon themed cutting and counting
- balancing in PE
- decorating the wooden fish with beads
- looking at different leaves
- learning how the leaves change colour in autumn

In Maths, we've been subitising to 4. Subitising is the ability to look at a small set of objects and instantly know how many there are without counting them. They have also used positional language to describe patterns of 4.

Mrs Hampshire and Mrs Bradbury were most impressed yet again when the children got dressed for PE, it only took them 12 minutes this week! They enjoyed learning how to balance in a variety of ways with Miss Emery.

Next Week...

We will continue to learn new phonic sounds 'll ff ss and s when it makes the 'z' sound for example in the words pigs. We'll also get creative with pumpkins and in Maths our focus will be comparison, using the language 'more than' and 'fewer than'.
