This Week...

It was lovely to see you all at parents evening this week, thank you for taking the time to come and see me.

This week in phonics we learned: 'ff ll ss and s saying /z/'.

They've been busy practising their segmenting and blending skills

In Maths, we've been comparing sets of objects identifying which set have 'more than' and which has 'fewer than'.

Mrs Hampshire and Mrs Bradbury were most impressed yet again when the children got dressed for PE, it only took them 10 minutes this week – much quicker than Y5/6 we were told! They enjoyed learning how to kick balls with the side of their foot to and use their foot to stop the ball.

Next Week...

In Phonics we will revise all sounds and tricky words taught.

In Maths they will reinforce their understanding of cardinality – that the last number in the count tells us 'how many' things there are altogether in a set of objects. They will further practise their 1:1 correspondence skill, by counting numbers at the same time as moving or tagging objects.
